Product: 3 sketchbook pages + Final piece

Description:

Sketchbook Page 1: brainstorm and create a word-map to help you decide on your directed study project

Sketchbook Page 2: research the theme or issue you are going to explore, the medium/materials you will be using and the elements and principles of art you will focus on. Sketches and text.

Sketchbook Page 3: outline your directed study in your sketchbook. Use the following headings and answer the questions:

1. Topic or Theme:

- Which topic or theme are you going to explore? Choose from the following: Identity, Culture, Environment, Society OR pick your own.
- Why is it important to you?

2. Elements and Principles of Art:

- Which elements and principles of art are you going to focus on when creating your piece? Minimum requirement of one element and one principle.

3. Medium and Materials:

- What medium will you be working in? Sculpture, painting, drawing, ceramics, mixed-media, photography etc.
- What materials will you require? Watercolour paper, pencils, drawing paper, charcoal, pastels, photography supplies, clay etc.

4. Purpose:

- What are you hoping to learn from your directed study? How will it help you grow as an artist?

5. Final Piece:

- What will you be making? General description of your final piece including size estimates and quantity if you are making more than one.

*You will have 5 classes to complete the directed study, starting on January 7
